The MBA with specialisation in Healthcare Management is offered jointly with <u>Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health</u>.






Students are required to declare specialisation in healthcare management at the point of admission.

Students must obtain a minimum GPA of 3.2 to be awarded the degree.


