TRAVELLING TO SINGAPORE

- ❑ Dual citizenship – travel with **same** passport used for STP application
- ❑ Submit online e-Arrival Card (SGAC) [HERE](#), 3 days before arrival in SG. Select 'Foreign Visitors' for IPA holders
- ❑ Print & bring completed IPA letter & e-Arrival Card acknowledgement
- ❑ **IMPORTANT!** Visit [ICA | Entering Singapore](#) for further details



DOCUMENTS TO BRING

- ☐ Marriage Certificate
- ☐ Birth Certificate of children
- ☐ Valid passports
- ☐ Insurance documents (Hospitalisation & Personal Accident coverage)
- ☐ Any medical report, as necessary



LONG TERM SOCIAL VISIT PASS (LTSVP)



- Applicable only for **spouse/children below age 17**, of STP holders after arriving in Singapore.
- Application for LTSVP can only be done after student completes STP formalities and obtained digital STP.
- Obtain application forms and instructions from Admissions
- Make an appointment at ICA to complete formalities for LTSVP application in person, within the validity of the entry stamp on passport.
- Student/STP holder has responsibility to ensure their spouse/child has a valid stay in SG.
- Spouse/Child may be required to undergo medical examination if cumulated length of stay exceeds 6 months

LONG TERM SOCIAL VISIT PASS (LTSVP)

Documents Required for Application:

- ☐ SOCIAL VISIT PASS FOR MBA STUDENT'S SPOUSE APPLICATION FORM R.081/2012
- ☐ MBA UNDERTAKING FOR UNIVERSITY'S SPONSORSHIP OF SOCIAL VISIT PASS FOR SPOUSE OR CHILD FOR MBA STUDENTS
- ☐ FORM 14 (*Please note that your spouse must sign this form personally*)
- ☐ FORM V39I (*Malaysians are not required to submit this form*)
- ☐ A copy of the marriage/child's birth certificate/ your student pass
- ☐ A copy of the insurance policy for hospitalization and personal accident coverage of each spouse or child to be sponsored

EXPENSES (GENERAL GUIDE)

- **Utilities:** Budget between \$100 and \$200 per month for utilities like electricity, water, internet, etc.
- **Groceries:** Groceries can cost anywhere from \$400 to \$600 monthly, depending on your eating habits
- **Food:** \$400 to \$600 monthly for food. Eating out regularly can significantly increase your expenses.
- **Transportation:** \$100 to \$800, depending on factors like commuting distance, transportation type, and frequency of travel.
- **Other Expenses:** Travel (e.g. Global Immersion Program, Exchange Program, etc, entertainment, personal care items, additional insurance (if necessary) and mobile phone plans.
- **Pre-School/Infant Care:** \$800 - \$\$1300 or higher

OFF CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

- Utown apartments can only accommodate students with accompanying spouse (no children allowed)
- Students arriving with spouse & children are required to look for off campus housing.
- Monthly rent may range approx. S\$3800 onwards for an apartment, depending on housing types (private apartments/public housing), facilities, location, and size.
- Locations near NUS - Pasir Panjang/Clementi/Buona Vista/Holland Village/Ghim Moh/Dover/ Queenstown/Telok Blangah/Commonwealth/Normanton Park/One-North
- Offers flexibility & convenience

OFF-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION: TIPS

- Arrive earlier for your apartment search.
- Do not enter into any tenancy contracts before your arrival in SG
- View the actual unit before committing to any rental contract
- Read carefully and negotiate/agree with all terms of tenancy agreement before committing.
- Inspect thoroughly and take detailed pictures of apartment during handover/on first day of move in. Take note of all existing defects.
- Take note on early termination clauses on lease, repairs/maintenance clauses, and any other restrictions (if any, e.g. smoking, pets, etc)
- Budget for utilities, internet, apartment maintenance.
