Admission Process



Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree
- Minimum 2 years of post-degree work experience
- Valid GMAT or GRE score (Executive Assessment is accepted for part-time MBA applicants with ≥5 years of work experience)
- TOEFL score ≥100 or IELTS score ≥7.0 if English was not the medium of instruction for your degree

Tuition Fees

S\$99,953 (inclusive of GST)

A non-refundable enrolment fee of S\$10,900 (inclusive of GST) is payable upon accepting your offer. Remaining fees are paid in fixed instalments.

Scholarships & Grants

Scholarships are merit-based and are awarded on a rolling basis, with around a third of each cohort receiving support. All applicants are automatically considered for scholarships - no separate application is required.

Note: APEC and ADB-JSP scholarships are only open to full-time MBA applicants who meet the eligibility criteria. Apply by the Round 2 deadline for consideration.

NUS alumni admitted to the program receive a **S\$15,000** grant, while alumni from NTU, SIT, SMU, SUSS or SUTD are eligible for a **S\$8,000** grant.

Application Deadlines for August 2026 Intake

We admit one intake each August. Applications open a year before the intake begins and are reviewed on a rolling basis. All rounds are equally competitive, but applying early lets you receive your outcome sooner and plan ahead.

Application fee: S\$100

Test Waivers (case-by-case basis)

- Part-time MBA applicants with ≥8 years of work experience may request for a GMAT/GRE/EA waiver.
- Applicants without an English-taught degree may request a TOEFL/IELTS waiver if they have at least 5 years of experience in an English-speaking environment.

Submit your waiver request in writing to the admissions team immediately after applying. Waivers are limited and granted only to top-performing candidates.

GMAT/GRE/EA waiver recipients are not eligible for scholarships.

Eligibility for Part-time Study

Part-time MBA applicants must be based in Singapore and hold a valid pass if not a Singapore citizen or permanent resident.






