

Typically, students take 3 courses per semester, with about 9 hours of class time weekly. Each course/elective meets once weekly; electives held during special terms will meet twice weekly if classes fall on weeknights. Weeknight classes run from 6.30-9.30pm; Saturday classes are 9.00am-12.30pm or 9.00am-4.30pm.

Financing & Scholarships

\$\$99,953 (inclusive of GST)

A non-refundable enrolment fee of S\$10,900 (inclusive of GST) is payable upon accepting your offer. Remaining fees are paid in fixed instalments.

Scholarships are merit-based and are awarded on a rolling-basis. All applicants are automatically considered for scholarships - no separate application is required.

NUS alumni admitted to the program receive a **\$\$15,000** grant, while alumni from NTU, SIT, SMU, SUSS or SUTD are eligible for a **\$\$8,000** grant.

Admission Requirements

- · Bachelor's degree
- Minimum 2 years of post-degree work experience
- Valid GMAT or GRE score (Executive Assessment is accepted for part-time MBA applicants with ≥5 years of work experience)
- TOEFL score ≥100 or IELTS score ≥7.0 if English was not the medium of instruction for your degree

Part-time MBA applicants must be based in Singapore and hold a valid pass if not a Singapore citizen or permanent resident.

Test Waiver Eligibility for Part-Time MBA Candidates

- Applicants with ≥8 years of work experience may request a GMAT/GRE/EA waiver.
- Applicants without an English-taught degree may request a TOEFL/IELTS waiver if they have at least 5 years of experience in an English-speaking environment.
- Waiver requests must be submitted in writing to the admissions team immediately after applying. Waivers are not guaranteed, so apply early in case testing is required. **GMAT/GRE/EA** waiver recipients are not eligible for scholarships.
